# Illuminating the pathway to sustained conservation















- Pay-for-Performance Program with TNC
  - Was run in Macon and Douglas Counties, distributing \$27,727 to six producers
- Pay-for-Performance Program with TNC and Siemer Milling
  - Was run in Clay, Effingham, Jasper, Richland, and Shelby Counties, distributing \$5,440 to one producer
- ISA non-GMO Program
  - Was run statewide, distributing ~\$30,000

- National STAR WebApp Design Phase II
  - o Currently: Listening sessions, project design and development
  - o April: Beta version of new WebApp available in IL
  - Aggregated data summaries generate a report for your district! Demonstrate importance, successes, and needs across the state.
- Conservation Improvement Plan
  - Prescreening for governmental, industry, and other programs (accounting for stackability)
